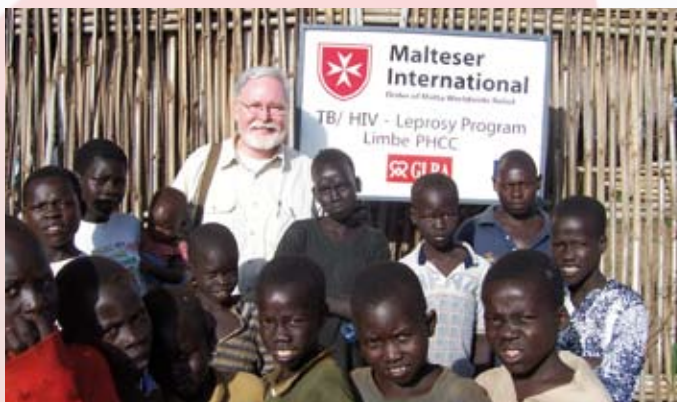
Companions' Benefits
